<p><b>Justification:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Wilshire Community Services (WCS) request additional funding to add a Clinical Supervisor to the team.</li> <li>• The Clinical Supervisor will be responsible for providing clinical supervision to pre-licensed clinicians. The Supervisor will also be responsible for building and maintaining educational elements designed to ensure pre-licensed individuals have the tools, training, and support to provide therapeutic services to individuals in an FSP program.</li> <li>• The FSP program is a therapy-focused program. The clinicians see their clients at least two times a week for therapy. With only one clinician on the team, it will be challenging to meet all clients twice a week and continue to provide the level of care that has been proven to produce positive results. Expanding the Older Adult FSP program and adding a Clinical Supervisor will make clinical services available to all clients at the desired and necessary level.</li> <li>• Looking at the even bigger picture, by providing opportunities for pre-licensed individuals to experience this type of work, WCS is investing in the future of community-based practices.</li> </ul> <p><b>Outcomes:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Program will continue to meet FSP outcomes: Reduced hospitalizations, homeless, incarceration, and psychiatric health facility days.</li> <li>• Expand clinical offerings, improved staff retention, and services.</li> <li>• Improved overall experiences with FSP leading to wellness and recovery outcomes.</li> </ul>
